CENTRAL LYON COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
TO OPEN BURNING October 17th

Effective Saturday, October 17th, burning will be open in the Central Lyon County Fire Protection District. A permit is required to burn. Burning is limited to clean vegetation and yard debris only. The burning of household trash and treated lumber is not permitted. Burn barrels are not permitted and you must have a minimum of one acre to obtain a burn permit.

The Fire District will be enforcing burning regulations more diligently and encourages everyone to obtain a permit. Those burning outside the regulations will be subject to fines.

Please be aware that conditions are still extremely dry. Use caution and follow the rules on the burn permit.

Permits will be available Monday, October 12th and may be obtained at the District Office, 231 Corral Drive, Dayton. You may also call the district office for a burn permit at 246-6209, or obtain a permit online at www.centrallyonfire.org.
