**Permittee, upon acceptance of this permit, agrees to the following conditions:** *(please initial)*

\_\_\_\_1. All commercial burn permits require permitting with the **State of Nevada- Bureau of Air Quality Planning** in addition to this permit. These can be obtained at [aims.ndep.nv.gov](http://aims.ndep.nv.gov), follow the instructions to create your organization on the web page. Once your organization creation is requested, NDEP will create it and email you, then access will be granted to apply for a "Burn Variance Application" to document your burn. Your organization only needs be created once. Print this permit and the NDEP permit to have available on site when burning.

\_\_\_\_2. Regular burn hours are sunrise to 12 Noon, Extinguish and monitor the burn for a minimum of 2 hours. Hours are subject to change.

\_\_\_\_3. Burn only if the wind is blowing **10 mph or less**. STOP ALL BURNING IF THE WEATHER CHANGES.

\_\_\_\_4. Burn only those materials that would not cause noxious odors or a large amount of smoke. Burning of plastics, rubber, toxic, dangerous or hydrocarbon products, are prohibited. **(CLFCA 307.2.5)**.

\_\_\_\_5. Burning of clean woody, forest, range, or yard vegetation is permitted. **Burning of household trash and treated wood or lumber is prohibited! (CLFCA 307.2.2 & 307.2.3)**.

\_\_\_\_6. Conduct open burning at least 50 feet from any structure or other combustible material. Conditions that could cause the fire to spread to within 50 feet of a structure shall be eliminated prior to ignition.

\_\_\_\_7. Keep piles reasonable and prudent in size and not less than 30 feet from structures or other combustibles. If burning in ditches, keep fire contained to small segments of the ditch at any one time.

\_\_\_\_8. A hose and nozzle connected to a portable water source shall follow burns on ditch banks and shall on site of all open burns. Other approved fire-extinguishing equipment, such as shovels, shall be readily available **(CLFCA 307.2.6)**.

\_\_\_\_9. Burning materials shall be constantly attended by a person knowledgeable in the use of the fire extinguishing equipment and familiar with the permit limitations that restrict open burning. An attendant shall

supervise the burning material until the fire has been extinguished and monitored for a minimum of 2 hours.

**ALL COMMERCIAL BURNS REQUIRE A SITE INSPECTION  
WITH RESPONSIBLE PARTY OR PROPERTY OWNER**

This permit is valid only under the conditions prescribed by law or by the District Chief relating to time, weather, burning specifications, firebreaks, and staffing requirements. The Permit does not relieve the user of any legal responsibility for the safe use of fire or allow burning to be done in violation of any State law, County ordinance, or local regulations restricting or regulating the use of fire. **This permit may be temporarily NULL AND VOID during suspension of burning by the District Fire Chief or his authorized representative.**

Any person who violates the terms or conditions of this Permit shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and may be cited as such (NRS 475). The expense of responses to and suppression of any emergency incident that is the result of a violation of this Permit, loss of control of burning or any escaped fire to adjacent property, may be charged to the Responsible Party whose violation caused the response of equipment and personnel.

The undersigned attests; I am the owner, legal occupant, or authorized representative of the above-described property. If I am not the property owner or authorized representative, I have obtained permission from the property owner to conduct open burning as permitted by this authorization. I agree to comply with all applicable fire laws, ordinances, and regulations. I understand that the property owner and Central Lyon Fire Protection District shall not be held responsible for any damages, losses, or liabilities resulting from the burning activities conducted under this permit. I further agree to comply with all specific terms and conditions of this permit.
